There will be an open house-style public meeting to provide an update on the I-75 Rouge River Detroit Downriver Connection project occurring **Tuesday January 23, 2017 from 5:30PM to 7:30PM**, located at **Taylor City Hall 23555 Goddard Road Taylor MI 48180**. The project is moving into the next phase, with major I-75 repairs continuing between Springwells Street and Clark Avenue. Rehabilitation of 11 additional bridges in multiple Downriver communities is scheduled to occur this spring 2018. There will be exhibits displaying the updated information and a new display with pictures of the work completed thus far.

There will be materials and translators available in Arabic as well as in Spanish. Accommodations can also be made for persons with disabilities and limited English-speaking abilities.
